K. Laxmareddy

Laxmareddy is the elder son of Kommureddy and Kanthamma of Choppadandi village and mandal. He was affected with polio in his childhood. The discrimination on the disable persons starts from the family no one in the family gives importance to the person who is physically challenged, same thing happened with Laxmareddy. Even in the school the children made fun with him, Due to this situation he always used to be away from his school mates. Very few friends understood the pain of him. The parents consulted doctors and he went through the surgery for two times but unfortunately all attempts met failure due to the innocence of the parents.



The interaction with the network associated person brought a lot of change with the suggestion given by him he started a Telephone booth. He made a survey on the project and identified the place near to his village. He contacted the local political leaders for getting the permission. Due to the interference of the local leaders the matter kept aside for two years. Finally he was successful in getting the project .The representatives of the net work met him and shared his ups and downs and trained him on the rights and entitlements, he got a new platform to convey his thoughts. Slowly after meeting with the other disabled persons he openly started sharing his inherited pleasures and pains. Net work gave the inputs on the rights of the PWDs and the entitlements provide by the government. With that he took a leading role in the group to the strengthen the PWDs.
