The parents consulted many doctors and made several attempts and as a part of treatment they gave electrical treatment and it brought some change that he could sit and able to do some work but he was unable to walk without support. His mother used to carry him to school it was very painful situation to his mother. The family members and his friends were very helpful and gave much priority to his words which made him bold and confident in all walks of the life. After his education he learnt the technical knowledge of TV mechanism and became a professional. His life has been changed totally after the marriage and developed the business and began to work for the organization and running an institute of skill development.



When NPdO team met him he was not aware of rights and the government schemes later on he was taught all these things. It brought much change in his attitude he began to think about the PWDs and started motivating them in all ways. In this process he made the groups and they were trained on the needs and the entitlements of the PWDs and how to achieve them.
