In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued examinations the Physically Handicapped (Blind, Deaf and Dumb) pupils studying in Government Institutions in Andhra Pradesh from payment of examination fee for the H.S.C., VIII standard and Technical Examinations in the State. Similar provision does not , however exist in the S.S.C. Examination Scheme approved in G.O.Ms.No.63 Edn., dt.16-1-69. In G.O.Ms.No.804 Edn., dt.3-7-75 orders were issued permitting candidates without school studies to appear for X class and VII Class Examinations as private candidates. In G.O.Ms.No.992 Edn., dt.28.9.1976, the collection of a fee of Rs.50/- towards exemption from attendance at schools were prescribed from all private candidates for the S.S.C. Examinations. The examination fee for X Class (S.S.C.) was also brought on to a uniform rate of Rs.25/- both regular and private candidates who appear for

2. In his letter 4th read above, the Commissioner for Government Examinations submitted proposals:-

To exempt the physically handicapped (Blind, deaf and Dumb) candidates appearing for the S.S.C. Examinations either as regular candidates from schools or as private candidates, from the payment of "Examination Fee", and 2) To exempt such of the above mentioned physically handicapped candidates appearing for the S.S.C. Examination

as private candidates, from the payment of "Exemption Fee" of Rs.50/-

The Government after careful examination consider that the proposals of the Commissioner for Government Examinations is a welfare measure to encourage the physically handicapped persons in the field of education and to enable them acquire the minimum general educational qualifications and direct that .

 a) The physically handicapped students (Blind, Deaf and Dumb) be exempted from the payment of examination fee for the S.S.C. and VII Class Common Examinations in respect of both regular and private candidates.

b) The candidates without school study, appearing for SSC Examination as private candidates to be exempted fo

c) the above mentioned concession can be availed or permitted to be availed bonafide students who are hand capped on account of blindness, deafness and dumbness. The candidates shall furnish along with their application

form for Examination a certificate in this regard obtained from a Civil Assistant Surgeon.

This order shall come into force, with effect from the March, 1980 Examinations.

This order issues with the concurrence of Finance and Planning Department-vide their U.O.No.2227/79, dates 27-12-1979.
